Last year we had only one person officially join our congregation. This year will be better because we will be offering a confirmation class and several adults have already requested membership transfers. However, since Mountain Vista has a history of welcoming both members and constituents into the full life of our congregation, there are many long term attenders who have never joined and several have wondered why they even should.

I am sensitive to the many valid reasons that prevent some people from entering into full connection with our congregation and denomination. I also realize that those who have LDS roots have a particularly difficult time making this commitment. I myself, as a cradle Roman Catholic, attended a United Methodist church for several years before I felt spiritually ready to make my vows. Before I made those vows, I taught Sunday school, pledged financial support, and directed the education program.

Recently, some folks realized for the first time that there are some disadvantages that accompany non-membership. Since the United Methodist church operates within the constraints of our “Book of Discipline” as amended by General Conference in 2012, we at MVUMC must follow these rules of our incorporation. Some of the rules involve leadership. For example, non-members cannot serve on the SPPR committee or chair our Trustees. Other rules, guide our annual meeting which is the Church/charge Conference in which we do our official business. This was the first year I can ever remember where folks were upset about being excluded from voting. Most years we have to beg people to attend. Membership does bring the privilege of voting on important church matters. On the other hand, we at MVUMC also struggle to fill our leadership positions and to manage our church affairs with a very limited number of professing members. (We have 169 active members, 273 active non-members and 109 children.)

But membership involves more than voting rules and service opportunities. It is a sign of accepting God’s grace in a particular and concrete way. Ours is an embodied and corporate faith. The commitment to membership is a promise to support each other by our prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness. Just like our New Year’s resolutions, we do not always live up to our commitments. Just like our marriage vows, we do not always keep our membership vows. Nonetheless, the very act of commitment, increases the likelihood that we will love and live better than if we had never made the promise at all.

Certified Lay Ministry Candidate's Corner

Several Weeks ago, Pastor Olga and I felt that a candidate's ministry message in each monthly newsletter would be appropriate. So, here is the January message! I have chosen to take the road to the pulpit, by going the route of the certified lay minister (CLM) and then (hopefully) off to becoming a local licensed pastor after that. I have prayed about going back to Iliff School of Theology, but the good Lord has said no to that. The CLM training consists of four intense modules of training and completion before a commitment service is held. They are: the call and covenant for ministry, the practice of ministry, organization for ministry, and the connection for ministry. The courses are not completed over night or in a few weeks. This will most likely be a yearlong process, if not a little longer. I am required to have a mutual ministry team that provides guidance and oversight for my training and progress; and that team has already been formed. However the training I go through doesn't stop there. The congregation also assists in my training. One of the things I am supposed to do is (Praise Team this is for you!) film the Praise or Worship Teams during the services and then WE get to watch the video together and make constructive comments!! During the summer I hope to be attending a one week ministry "boot camp" in Denver that gives me much needed CLM immersion training and the same training is also required as one of the steps for local license pastor candidacy. As a congregation and to each of you individually, I appreciate the support and am grateful for the family oneness that all of you give me in this endeavor. Please pray for Raquel and I as we go down this path together. Who knows where we will eventually be sent off to!!

Let the adventure begin!!



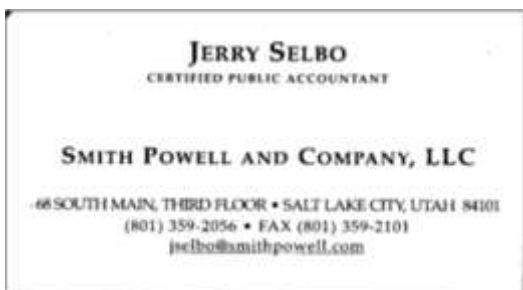
