WE'RE GETTING A NEW MINISTER!! OMG

Some will be sad; some may cry; some will have anxiety; heck, some may even be happy. The congregation will have a mix of feelings about these changes. Changes tend to make us anxious, so let's pray that God, our Bishop, the District Superintendent and Cabinet will bring us the best minster for our Christ-centered church to continue on our mission to experience, express, and expand God's love.

It's OK to mourn a bit about Rev. Olga leaving. BUT don't make her feel guilty. She prayed, counseled family and friends and made the decision to retire. Not an easy decision because she loves Mountain Vista and its members. Many members are now personal friends and those relationships will change for a while once she retires. Honor her decision. Send cards or a note telling Rev Olga what she means to us and how she changed our lives. She'll cherish those notes.

But our minister leaving is only part of the story. The other side is that we are getting a new minister! Getting a new minister is like getting a new teacher, a new boss, or department manager. In some respect it's also like getting a step-parent. That is to say there are two sides to the picture. Neither the step-parent nor the children know each other's story.

I've been a new boss, a new teacher, a new department manager, and a new-step parent. Change occurs because the new person is different than the previous person. An original parent had years to learn their kids story. So they know their child's loves, fears, strengths, weaknesses, favorite toys, friends, and so on. But the new step-parent doesn't. Rev Olga, like an original parent, had some years to get to know us and our story. The new minister, won't know our story. Won't know my story! Just like the new step-parent doesn't know the children's stories, the new minister won't know ours. They won't know each of our gifts, personal struggles, strengths, the chinks in our faith. Ugh they won't know that a certain church program is my baby!! Heck, the new minister won't even know my name!! (So as Rev Olga always says 'wear your name tags!')

The change won't be easy for the new minister either. Imagine stepping in front of 100 unfamiliar faces to give that first sermon. Standing in front of these church members, each with a comparative eye on them wondering 'how will the liturgy be different? What is their preaching style like? Imagine the stress of coming to our church with many unknowns. Not knowing Jean Ann does the quilting thing; Barb is in charge of the nursery, Jerry is involved in the music at the 11 service, etc. and who are these people!! So let's be merciful and full of grace and cut the new minister some slack! Don't be like a step-child with an attitude that says 'hey, you are not my real dad/mom'. Instead, give the new minister a MVUMC loving welcome, get excited about change, about a new vision and direction. Let's trust God and our new spiritual leader.

Can we do things to make a smoother transition from one minister to another? Can we get to know each other's stories quicker? Well, remember when Rev Olga came to MVUMC. Many were mourning the loss of Rev Steve and we needed to get to know our new minister quickly so we could move on. So, we set up a transition program which included a series of meetings between Rev Olga and small groups of MV members. Groups met at different member's homes to talk and begin to know each other's stories. From all the interactions, we were soon developing new directions for MVUMC. We are planning to do this again with our new minister! So get ready for the transition work. Other things you can do? Welcome and love the new minister and thank Rev Olga for all she has done. Amen

She received an M.Div. from Duke Divinity School and a B.A. from Mary Baldwin University's Program for the Exceptionally Gifted. Before Riverside, Christian worked in the Obama White House as Deputy Director for White House Operations. She's also worked for the Harlem Children's Zone with low-income families and in the Church of the Savior community in Washington, DC supporting those returning from incarceration.

Worship Leader

Bishop Karen P. Oliveto serves as the leader of the Mountain Sky Episcopal Area of The United Methodist Church, which includes the Rocky Mountain and Yellowstone annual (regional) conferences. It includes 400 congregations in Colorado, Montana, Wyoming, Utah, and a small section of Idaho.

Bishop Oliveto was elected to the episcopacy after serving as the first woman pastor of the 12,000-member Glide Memorial United Methodist Church in San Francisco, Calif. She is the first woman to serve as senior pastor of one of The United Methodist Church's 100 largest congregations. She served Glide from 2008 until her election as bishop.

Dear Olga Hard:

I would personally like to thank all of the over 90 people who came to Faith & Poverty Day at the Utah Capitol last week. You need to know that we made a difference. Last year we fought off a bill that would have doubled the sales tax on food. This year we are supporting a bill to completely eliminate the state portion of the sales tax on food.

The other big issue we discussed on Thursday was issuing a \$100 million bond to address Utah's housing crisis. On Friday, the Democrats in the Legislature announced that this is one of their five priorities this year. Over the coming weeks we will be working to convince Republicans from cities that also have severe housing challenges to support this idea. We will be meeting every Thursday in February at 10 AM in the Seagull Room of the Senate Building -- starting this Thursday, February 1, 2018. Please let me know if you can come on this Thursday or in one of the next couple weeks.

Together we can help legislators to focus more of their time and attention on the needs of low income people during the remaining 40 days of the state legislative session.
