Some of you have been noticing Jane Tago's photos on our Facebook page. Several years ago she responded to a post from the United Methodist website Rethink Church. They challenged those who enjoyed photography to use their passion as a way to grow in their knowledge and love of God. During Advent and Lent, a calendar is sent with quotes from scripture. The photographer (Jane) then takes photographs that speak to each verse, and then she shares them with us on FaceBook.

On UMW Sunday, February 18, 2018, Mt Vista United Methodist Women was honored to present a Special Mission Recognition to Olga Hard. This annual award was a gift of love and gratitude. A contribution in her name has been made to support mission work for children, youth and women around the world. In addition she received flowers and a certificate. An engraved paver will also be added to the gallery pavilion.

Here is part of what her nomination said. Olga is an example of Christ in everyday life, coming to Methodism as an adult. She has been a visible and supportive part of Mt. Vista United Methodist Women. In fact, her gentle but persistent nudging made the reactivation of this unit a reality. Without that, UMW at Mt. Vista, would have, no doubt remained in the past. She volunteers regularly at the UMCOR Depot and on Fridays at the thrift store, sorting, pricing and restocking inventory. She's weeded our gardens and watered our plants, loaded the dishwasher, answered phones, swept floors, taken out the trash and encouraged recycling. She's taught Sunday school, led Bible studies, served the hungry, visited the state legislature and advocated for the under-served and marginalized. She has mentored our members, counseled those in need, welcomed visitors, rejoiced with us in our triumphs, girded us up in our sadness, administered our sacraments and taught us by word, deed and example. Second, when our new pastor arrives, we will be setting up several small discussion groups where everyone in our church family can gather to get acquainted with our new pastor, and to receive and share information, ideas, and hopes for these next stages in our church's growth. **From: Bob Nohavec:**

I contacted Rocky Mountain Power this morning and requested a summary of our electric bills at Mountain Vista for the years 2015, 2016, and 2017. Here are the totals:

2015 - \$5986.31

2016 - \$3597.54 (I believe the solar panels were installed in May)

2017 - \$1236.02 (This is the first full year of solar panel activity)

That's pretty impressive. Thanks to Mike Van Voorhis, who came up with the idea of the LLC, and with the generous support of those members of our congregation who joined that LLC, and to the anonymous benefactor who agreed to underwrite the balance of the cost through annual contributions, and to an unnamed crusader for the entire project, Mountain Vista is saving about \$4,750 a year in annual electrical costs as compared to the 2015 totals. In ten years, we'll have saved enough to buy a new Mercedes

**From: Mike Van Voorhis:**

A review of bills from Rocky Mountain Power has been made to identify performance metrics for the solar power generation equipment installed April 2016. The system has now operated for two "solar seasons" (April to March). The average monthly electricity cost for 2017 was \$83, a reduction of 73% of 2016 costs of \$312. The average costs for 2015, prior to system install, was \$336.

The electricity consumption during 2017 was 1633 kwh/mo, reduced from 1940 kwh/mo during 2016 and 2750 kwh/mo during 2015. Changes made to Mountain Vista UMC HVAC equipment and operating habits contributed to these reductions which avoid costly "demand" charge rate schedules. The solar equipment generated 1548 kwh/mo during 2017 and 1594 kwh/mo during 2016. These offset average monthly consumption by 95% and 58% for 2017 and 2016.

The electricity consumption and generation for upcoming calendar year 2018 is expected to be similar to performance of 2017. Energy costs are also expected to be similar provided demand peaks do not exceed the threshold for rate schedule changes. The peak of 2017 was 28 kw and 2016 was 32 kw during the July thru August periods.
