# **Inquiring Minds Want To Know!**

What would I like from the congregation in celebration of my 6 years as your pastor? Well, since several of you have asked, I guess I will tell you.

I would like to retire knowing that the finances of MVUMC are in good shape. For the last six years, I have prayed, and worried and struggled with our limited income. Our yearly income has actually fallen by \$30,000 during my tenure. And unlike today, 2012 was an economically depressed time for our community. We are now living in a robust economy but our income continues to fall.

We have tried to fix the deficit by cutting back. In the past 6 years, we have cut staff, refinanced our mortgage for better terms, limited our use of paper, cut my health benefits, and installed solar panels. I have never served a more frugal church. (Yes we have accomplished some special building projects during this time but these projects were completed using special designated gifts which could not be used for everyday operations.)

This is an amazing congregation! You have touched my life, the lives of our members, and the lives of many people in our broader community. Meals, and rides, and prayers have been generously offered. You have poured out your lives in service to Family Promise, Pinecliff Camp, the Linus Project, and Sandwich ministries.

But something is wrong with our stewardship. And it may well be my fault. When I arrived I put a stop to the Stewardship campaign that had taken much time and energy and which appeared to me to have limited results. We then instituted a plan to stress year round giving and attempted to provide year round information on our financial status. This has obviously not been enough and I apologize sincerely.

Last year, 14 families gave over \$5000 dollars each for a total of \$137,000. These 14 "giving units" provided over 1/3 of our budget. 62 other families provide the bulk of the other 2/3 of our budget. These gifts are amazing and appreciated and yet they are well short of our needs.

I am heart sick.

But I have done all I can do – including tithing my own income. Now I must leave the care of this community in your hands. I know that God has big plans for MVUMC and if I could receive any parting gift from you, it would be that each of you would consider investing more of your income and your lives into the service of God through MVUMC.


