Message from our new District Superintendent

Dear friends,

My wife Bev and I live in Salt Lake City where we served Christ UMC for the past six years. We have three grown children who live outside of Utah, and parents who live in Salt Lake City. Bev and I served churches in Eagle, Colorado Springs, Denver and Salt Lake City. I also took a few years away from the pulpit to write, and I will be happy to share some of my books with you as I can.

I feel a bit like the old missionary who served in a remote foreign field for many years, laboring by himself. The mission board finally sent him an assistant, a young man fresh out of seminary. The young pastor's head was newly filled with deep theological thoughts and musings. The old missionary gathered the people of the rural village together around the community well. He introduced his new assistant and asked the man if he would like to say a few words to the villagers. The young man rose to speak and the old missionary prepared to translate. "We must always remember," he began, "that there is a distinct and essential difference between Jesus as God's kerygma in the contingencies of human existence, and Christ as logos and eschatological manifestation of the ground of our being." Then he waited for the old missionary to translate THAT. The old man scratched his head. He finally rose and spread out his arms to his people. "Friends," he said, "he says he loves you and he's glad to be here."

I think that is really what I want to say. I love you and I'm glad to be here with you these next few years. I hope to get to know many of you as we work together. Also... may I ask a favor? From time to time I will be traveling throughout the district. If any of you have a spare bedroom (no meals needed), it will save the conference money to stay in homes where possible. Please email me if this might be a possibility for you sometime and I'll save your name in case I am in need of a place to stay when in your area. And, in advance, *thank you*.
